What Is Big Brothers Big Sisters?

Vision: All youth achieve their full potential.

Mission: Create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. **Accountability:** By partnering with parents/guardians, volunteers, and others in the community, we are accountable for each child in our program achieving:

- Higher aspirations, greater confidence, and better relationships
- Avoidance of risky behaviors
- Educational success

Fun Facts about Big Brothers Big Sisters of South-Central PA:

- All funds raised through Bowl for Kids' Sake stay local, supporting youth in the region near each bowling event.
- Big Brothers Big Sisters has been serving South-Central PA for over 40 years!
- Youth in our program report that they avoid risky behaviors such as drugs and alcohol (93%), have built a foundation of trust with an adult (92%) and expect to attend college (76% ages 15+).

What Is Bowl for Kids' Sake?

Bowl for Kids' Sake is Big Brothers Big Sisters' signature fundraiser. Bowl for Kids' Sake is the perfect way for individuals to make an impact on our community – it only takes a little bit of effort to raise the money that is vital to our program's success. Where Does the Money Go?

100% of your donation goes directly to help serve local children. Big Brothers Big Sisters depends on donations to conduct background checks on volunteers to ensure child safety, and provide ongoing professional support for children, families and volunteers to build and sustain long-lasting relationships.



What Does a Team Captain Do?

Step 1: Register

It's easy to do online – just visit <u>capbigs.org/events</u> and follow the simple instructions! You can choose to register all (or some) of your team members when you create your team.

Step 2: Set a Goal

Set a team fundraising **goal** – AIM HIGH! We require each team to raise a minimum of \$500 (for a team of 5) or \$100 a person. Many of our teams raise over \$1,000!

Step 3: Recruit

Find 4 people to join your team. It could be friends, family, or co-workers. You've set an ambitious goal, so choose people who will help you exceed it!
